PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

This notice is to declare that the State of Utah has proposed a Stipulated Compliance Order to LW Miller Transportation Services, Inc. This Public Notice is issued pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R305-7-402 and R317-8-1.9, to provide opportunity for public comment on the proposed settlement of an enforcement action. The proposed settlement is for the purpose of resolving alleged violations of Utah Code Annotated 19-5 (Water Quality Act), and is a resolution of enforcement proceedings brought against LW Miller Transportation Services, Inc.
