PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO RENEW A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

ATI Titanium utilizes treated groundwater to produce titanium sponge. In the process they use groundwater and will produce wastewater to be treated though chemical precipitation, pH adjustment, and filter press. The treated effluent will then be discharged to the Great Salt Lake. The water is obtained from wells in Skull Valley and then is treated by Reverse Osmosis and distributed to the facilities. ATI Titanium is anticipating average effluent flows from the titanium metal sponge manufacturing plant at 750,000 gallons per day (gpd) of treated effluent. The wastewater consists of approximately 440,000 gpd of non-contact sources and 290,000 gpd of contact water

PUBLIC COMMENTS

During the public comment period provided under Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R317-8-6.5, any interested person may submit written comments on the draft permit and may request a public hearing if no hearing has already been scheduled. A request for a public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. All comments will be considered in making the final decision and shall be answered as provided in UAC R317-8-6.12.
