Division of Water Quality Utah Department of Environmental Quality Public Notice of Intent to Modify and Renew the General Permit for Coal Mine Operations Permit No. UTG040000

Purpose of Public Notice

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is soliciting comments on the request to modify and renew the General Permit for Coal Mine Operations. The General Permit for Coal Mine Operations is issued by the Director of the Division of Water Quality under authority of the *Utah Water Quality Act, Title 19, Chapter 5, Utah Code Annotated 2004*, as amended and *Utah Administrative Code R317-8*. Under Section 19-1-301.5, effective May 8, 2018, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue.
