PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE CALL FOR DATA
FOR THE 2022 INTEGRATED REPORT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) is assessing the water quality of surface waters of the State (e.g., streams, lakes, etc.) for the 2022 Integrated Report to determine support of their designated beneficial uses. The Integrated Report is submitted every two years for Environmental Protection Agency approval and includes the 305(b) assessment report and 303(d) list of impaired waters. Utah's designated beneficial uses are drinking water, recreation, aquatic wildlife, agriculture, and the Great Salt Lake ([Utah Administrative Code R317-2-6](#)). DWQ monitoring teams and cooperators collect water quality data that is used for evaluating the water quality of surface waters. We are currently soliciting any additional water quality data and information from individuals or organizations to assist DWQ in making assessment decisions for the 2022 Integrated Report.

CALL FOR DATA SUBMISSIONS

Data and information submissions are invited any time prior to the close of business on Thursday, April 8, 2021. Data providers must submit files electronically using the submission processes and tools provided on the [Call for Data](#) webpages
