

Proposed FY2025 Division of Water Quality Wastewater Operator Certification Fee Changes

This email provides clarification to the proposed FY25 fee changes for the Wastewater Operator certification program.

In the near future, wastewater operators will have the opportunity to choose between a computer-based certification test and a paper-based certification test.

Wastewater Operators who opt for a computer-based test will submit an application and fee to the Division of Water Quality. For FY25, the proposed fee amount is \$50. This fee is for administrative costs only. Wastewater Operators will pay a separate fee directly to the testing center which covers use of the testing center service and the exam. For 2024-2025, the testing center fee is estimated to be \$89 for a 2-hour testing time and \$106 for a 3-hour testing time.

Wastewater Operators who opt for a paper-based test will submit an application and fee to the Division of Water Quality. For FY25, the proposed fee amount is \$200. This fee includes administrative costs and the cost of the exam.
