PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO MODIFY A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

The Central Weber Sewer Improvement District (CWSID) serves the communities of Farr West, Hooper, Harrisville, North Ogden, Ogden, Pleasant View, Marriott-Slaterville, Riverdale, South Ogden, West Haven, South Weber, Washington Terrace, Weber County, and portions of Roy, Plain City, and Uintah. The permit has been modified to include biological oxygen demand (BOD) and total suspended solids (TSS) percent removal requirements, in accordance with Utah Secondary Treatment Standards, *Utah Administrative Code R317-1-3.2*. The facility is located at latitude 41°16'18" and longitude 112°02'49".

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Public comments are invited any time prior to the deadline of the close of business on <u>June 28th, 2021</u>. A public hearing can be requested, although must be filed during the comment period.
