Division of Water Quality Utah Department of Environmental Quality Public Notice of Permit UTU-19-AP-1C3C2E8 Temperature Survey Mechanical Integrity Test Waiver

Purpose of Public Notice

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is soliciting comments on the request for a waiver to include Temperature survey methods for the internal requirement of Mechanical Integrity Testing for permit Underground Injection Control (UIC) Class III Draft permit UTU-19-AP-1C3C2E8. The Waiver is issued by the Director of the Division of Water Quality (DWQ) under authority of 40 CFR § 144.16 – Waiver of requirement by Director. Under Section R317-7-13 the Director of DWQ will investigate and provide written response to all citizen complaints duly submitted. In addition, the Director shall not oppose intervention in any civil or administrative proceeding by any citizen where permissive intervention may be authorized by statute or rule. The Director will publish notice of and provide at least 30 days of public comment on any proposed settlement of any enforcement action.
