PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO ISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

Logan City WWTP consists of a 7-cell facultative lagoon system and additional treatment wetlands. Total treatment area is 460 Acres of Lagoons, 240 acres of treatment wetlands. During the previous public comment period for permit renewal that ended July 15 2020, new permit effluent limits were instituted for Dissolved Oxygen Minimum Monthly Average. While the facility has started building a new facility to bring it into compliance with the new discharge requirements for the Cutler Reservoir TMDL, it would have difficulty meeting the new limit with the existing lagoons and treatment wetlands. As a result a compliance schedule in the new permit will allow the facility to operate under its current conditions until a time when it can comply with the new permit limits. This will be the only item open to comment during the public comment period.
