PUBLIC NOTICE OF NEW UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to issue a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under the authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Utah Code Sections 19-5-104 and 107. "Permit" refers to UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement Of Basis (including the Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs)) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

BACKGROUND

Riverton City Green Artesian Well Drinking Water Plant will be a newly constructed facility designed to treat groundwater from the Riverton City Green Artesian Well. The new water treatment facility will supply clean drinking water to Riverton City and surrounding areas. The water will be treated using reverse osmosis and the reject waste stream water will be discharged into the Jordan River.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Public comments are invited any time prior to the deadline of the close of business on **March 10, 2022**. A public hearing can be requested, although must be filed during the comment period.
