PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to grant a variance to the Technology Based Phosphorus Effluent Limit compliance to Springville City Wastewater Treatment Plant (Springville). Pursuant to UAC R317-1-3.3 and corresponding provisions of the Utah Water Quality Act.

BACKGROUND

Springville submitted a variance request, dated December 7, 2020 to the Utah Division of Water Quality "DWQ", seeking a variance to the TBPEL implementation. The Variance Request is based on the fact that Springville is currently in the process of implementing their chosen option for long term compliance with nutrient effluent limitations; however due to unforeseen circumstances that occurred since the current Variance was implemented such improvements cannot be completed prior to the conclusion of the current Variance (March 1, 2021). The new deadline will be January 1, 2022.
