### PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE INTENTION OF THE STATE OF UTAH TO ISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS.

## **BACKGROUND**

The facility is organic certified and adheres to the strict cleaning requirements to meet this standard. As part of the cleaning process about 300 grams of food grade powders are discharged to the POTW a month. The equipment is cleaned with chemicals that adhere to the organic production standard. The process wastewater discharge is from the cleaning process with an estimated discharge to the POTW of 200 gallons per day. The discharge will be regulated by the categorical standard found in 40 CFR 439.

# **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Public comments are invited any time prior to the deadline of the close of business on <u>August 28, 2020</u>. A public hearing can be requested although must be filed during the comment period which will end on <u>August 28, 2020</u>. After considering public comments the director may execute the permit issuance, revise it or abandon it. The director will not publish a notice of decision provided the permit will be signed without any changes and no comments are received during the public comment period.
