PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE INTENTION OF THE STATE OF UTAH TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS.

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BACKGROUND

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Wastewater generated by metal finishing processes is discharge to the publicly owned treatment works (POTW) which is owned and operated by Corinne. Tarter Gate West has been reporting self-monitoring results on discharge monitoring reports. In the last five years TGW has had a good compliance history. After considering public comments the director may execute the permit issuance, revise it or abandon it. The director will not publish a notice of decision provided the permit will be signed without any changes and no comments are received during the public comment period.
