DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY UTAH DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PUBLIC NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AN UPDES BIOSOLIDS PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to issue a Utah Pollution Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

TNT Waste Services (TWS) services septic tanks and systems for the public. TWS wants to use a dewatering box to dewater the septage contents prior to disposing of them at a landfill. A dewatering box is a double walled box that allows the water to percolate through the first layer and drain out, while holding the solids back. The separated liquid is transferred to another container for further treatment. In their case, TWS plans to evaporate the liquid. This liquid will not be permit for discharge to surface water, or groundwater.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Public comments are invited any time prior to the deadline of the close of business on <u>August 23, 2021</u>. During the public comment period provided under R317-8-6.5, any interested person may submit written comments on the draft permit and may request a public hearing, if no hearing has already been scheduled. A request for a public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. All comments will be considered in making the final decision and shall be answered as provided in R317-8-6.12. After considering public comments on the Permit, the Division of Water Quality may issue, or revise it.
